#### REGULATED AREA/DEVELOPMENT AREA/SPECIAL DEVELOPMENT AREA-----

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# EXISTING BUILT UP/DEVELOPED OR DEVELOPING/UNDEVELOPED AREAS LAND USE ZONING REGULATIONS

## 1. Short Title Commencement

- (i)These regulations shall be called the ... Existing Built UP/Developed or Developing Undeveloped areas under Land Use Zoning Regulations.
- (ii) These regulations shall be extend to the ... Regulated Area/Development Area/Special Development Area.
- (iii) These regulation shall come into force with effect from the date of the approval of Master Plan.

#### 2. **Definitions**

- (i) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise required :-
- (a) 'Existing Built Up Area' means an area within a Regulated Area/Development Area/Special Development Area, greater part whereof has been developed as a business, industrial or residential area, with all essential facilities, like road, water supply, sewerage, electricity, etc. and has been defined as such in the notifications by the Controlling Authority/Development Authority/Special Area Development Authority.
- Provided also that any area developed within the existing Built Up/Developed after systematic planning by any individual or company, association or body of individuals or Government/Semi Government of public undertaking, shall not be included.
- (b) 'Developing/undeveloped Area' means an area situated within the limits of regulated area of development area, but outside the limits of built up area, which has been defined an delineated as such in the Master Plan.

Provided that if the Master Plan has not been prepared or is under preparation, the limits of built up area shall be as per the area identified and delineated by the Controlling Authority/Development Authority/Special Area Development Authority.

Provided also that any area developed within the existing built up area, after systematic planning, by any individual or company, association or body of individuals or Government/Semi Government or public undertaking, shall not be included in earmarking the built up area but shall be treated as a Developing Area.

- (c) 'Regulated Area' means the regulated area declared under section 3 of the U.P. Regulation of Building operation Act, 1958.
- (d) 'Development Area' means the Development Area declared under section 3 of the U.P. Urban Planning and Development Act-1973.
- (e) 'Special Development Area' means the Special development Area declared under section 3 of U.P. Special Area Development Authority Act, 1986.
- (f) 'Competent Authority' of the Regulated Area/Development Area/Special Development Area means the Controlling Authority/Development Authority/ Special Area Development Authority.
- (ii)Words and expressions not defined in these regulations but used in the Act, Rules, Regulations/bye-laws or the Master Plan, shall have the meaning assigned to them in the Act, Rules Regulations bye-law or the Master Plan.

- (iii) Notwithstanding any thing to the contrary contained in any of the enactments aforementioned or the rules, regulations, bye laws are directions there under Zoning Regulations for the Existing Built up/Developed Area, in a regulated/Development area, shall consists of predominantly residential, commercial, industrial, parks, open speces and green verges, agricultural and green belt Govt., Semi Govt. and other office uses and the uses prohibited thereunder as also the uses permissible on application to the competent Authority with stipulations therefore shall be under:-
- 3. Zoning Regulations for Built Up Areas.
- 3.1 Predominantly Residential
- (a) Uses Prohibited
- (i) Heavy & extensive, noxious, obnoxious, hazardous and extractive inustries.
- (ii) Ware-housing, storage and Godowns or perishable, hazardous and inflammable goods.
- (iii) Junkeyards
- (iv) Wholesale Mandies
- (v) Forest land, Grazing land of an area exceeding 0.5 hectares.
- (vi) Hospitals treating contagious disease or mental patients.
- (vii) Slaughter House.
- (viii) Dairy and Poultry Farms
- (ix) Farm Houses
- (x) Animal raising and riding stables.
- (xi) Workshops for servicing & repairs
- (xii) Processing and sale of farm products
- (xiii) Cemeteries, cremation grounds and grave yards.

## Uses Permissible on Application to Competent Authority after careful consideration of the merits of individual applications and depending on the character and road Network of the Area in question.

- (i) Survive industries requiring power upto two H.P.
- (ii) Newspaper office and Printing Press
- (iii) Atta Chakki
- (iv) Coal, wood and Timber yard.
- (v) Water Supply installations including treatment plants.
- (vi) Sewage Disposal works.
- (vii) Gas installation and Gas works.
- (viii) Electric Power Plants
- (ix) Bus & Truck Terminals and Depots.
- (x) Service Stations.
- (xi) Stands for vehicles on hire like Taxi's & Scooters

- (xii) Railway yards, Railway Stations and siding.
- (xiii) Helipads
- (xiv) Commercial uses of transient nature like travelling cinemas, circus, theatres and other shows.
- (xv) Public Assembly Halls and Cultural Centres.
- (xvi) Hotels & Restaurants, Motels and Carvan Parks.
- (xvii) Polytechnic and higher technical institutions requiring machinery etc.
- (xviii) Sports Stadium
- (xix) Government offices
- (xx) Public Utility installation
- (xxi) Commercial Use

Floor area ration for above permissible uses shall be 100 with a maximum ground floor area shall be 150 with a maximum ground floor coverage of 35%. In case of Group housing permissible density shall be 25% higher than proposed in the Master Plan for that area.

## 3.2 Predominantly Commercial

## (a) Uses Prohibited

- (i) Heavy, extensive, noxious, obnoxious hazardous and extractive industries.
- (ii) Hospitals treating contagious disease or mental patients.
- (iii) Slaughter Houses.
- (iv) Cemeteries, creamation ground and grave yards.
- (v) Poultry Farms and Farm Houses
- (vi) Animals raising or riding stables.

- (i) Non polluting industries as per Annexure-1 requiring power upto 10 H.P.
- (ii) Warehousing, storage or perishable hazardous and inflammable goods
- (iii) Junk Yards.
- (iv) Coal, wood and Timber yards.
- (v) Polytechnics and higher technical institution requiring machinery etc.
- (vi) Water Supply installations including treatment plants.
- (vii) Sewage disposal works.
- (viii) Gas installation and Gas works
- (ix) Electric power plants
- (x) Workshop for servicing and repairs of farm machinery
- (xi) Hotels, Motels and Caravan Parks.
- (xii) Bus & Truck Terminals and depots.
- (xiii) Service Station
- (xiv) Stands for vehicles on hire like Taxies and Scooters.
- (xv) Railway yards, railway station and siding.

- (xvi) Helipads
- (xvii) Sports Stadium
- (xviii) Public Utility installations.
- (xix) Schools, colleges, institutions offering general education courses
- (xx) Animal raising or riding stables.

Floor area ratio for above permissiable uses shall be 150 with maximum Gr. floor coverage of 30%.

## 3.3 Predominantly Industrial

#### (a) Uses Prohibited

- (i) Residential dwelling except those of watch and ward and ward and essential operational staff.
- (ii) Schools/colleges offering general education courses
- (iii) Hospitals treating contagious disease or mental patients.
- (iv) Hotels, Motels and Caravan Parks.
- (v) Hostel and Boarding Houses.
- (vi) Slaughter Houses

- (i) Noxious, obnoxious and hazardous industries except quarrying of temporary nature of gravel sand, clay or store for purposes of development of the area.
- (ii) Storage of permissible, hazardous and inflammable goods.
- (iii) Junk yards.
- (iv) Coal and Timber yard
- (v) Polytechnic and higher technical institutions with or without machinery.
- (vi) Sports stadium
- (vii) Sewage disposal works.
- (viii) Gas installations and gas works.
- (ix) Electric Power plants.
- (x) water supply installation including treatment plants.
- (xi) Bus and truck terminals/Depots.
- (xii) Service stations.
- (xiii) Railway yards, Railway stations & sidings.
- (xiv) Helipads, Dock yards and gellies.
- (xv) Cemeteries cremation and grave yards.
- (xvi) Religious buildings, cultural and philanthropic associations.
- (xvii) Hospitals, Medical Center and Nursing homes.
- (xviii) Government Semi-Government professional & business offices.

- (xix) Banks and financial institutions.
- (xx) Public utility buildings.
- (xxi) Commercial use of Transient nature like travelling comeas, circus, theaters & other shows.
- (xxii) Stands for vehicles on hire like taxies or scooter etc.
- (xxiii) Dairy and poultry farms, and farm houses.
- (xxiv) Animal raising or riding stables.
- (xxv) Workshop for servicing, repairing of farm machinery.
- (xxvi) Processing and sale of ferm produce.

#### NOTE:-

Different types of industries are permitted in predominantly industrial zone i.e. Service industry, Light manufacturing industry, Extensive industry, Heavy industry, Noxious/Obnoxious, hazardous industry and extractive industries are to be as per Annexure-II. Floor Area Ratio for above permissible uses shall be 50 with a maximum ground floor coverage of 25%

#### 3.4 Parks :-

**Uses Prohibited** 

Any building or structure which is not required for open air recreation.

## 3.5 Open Spaces and Green Verges:

#### (a) Uses Prohibited

Any Building or structure except those ancillary to open spaces and parks.

## (b) Uses Permissible on Application to Compotent Authority:

- (i) Building and structure ancillary to uses premitted to open spaces and parks such as stand for vehicles on Hire like Taxis and Scooters.
- (ii) Commercial use of Transient Nature like cinemas, circus and other shows.
- (iii) Public Assembly Halls
- (iv) Cultural Centres.
- (v) Restaurant and Caravan parks.
- (vi) Sports Stadium.
- (vii) Open air theatre.
- (viii) Open air cinemas.

## 3.6 Predominantly Agriculture and Green Belt

- (iv) Sewage disposal works
- (v) Gas installations and Gas works
- (vi) Electric Power Plant.
- (vii) Water supply installations including treamtent plant.
- (viii) Hospital treating contagious disease or mental patients.
- (ix) Bus and Truck Terminals/Depots.
- (x) Service Stations.
- (xi) Helipads and Air Strips.
- (xii) Cemeteries, crematorium grave yards.
- (xiii) Carvan parks.

Floor area ratio for above premissible uses shall be 25 with a maximum ground floor coverage of 10%.

- (x) Workshop for servicing and repairs.

(Processing and sale of farm produce)

- (i) Residential dwellings.
- (ii) Hotels, Motels and Cravan Park.
- (iii) Commercial uses
- (iv) Water supply installations including treamtent plant.
- (v) Sewage disposal works

- (vi) Gas installation and gas works
- (vii) Bus and Truck Terminals/Deposts.
- (viii) Service Stations.

- (x) Railway Stations and yards.
- (xi) Helipads
- (xii) Cultural centres.
- (xiii) Polytechnic and higher technical institutions.

Floor area ratio for above premissible uses shall be 150 with a maximum ground floor coverage of 30%.

- 4. The non-polluting industries permitted in commercial areas and industries that may be permitted in industrial areas of the built up areas of the town/cities, industries which shall not be permitted in built up areas of towns/cities, shall be as under:

## (b) Industries that may be permitted in industrial areas of the built up areas of the town/cities.

- (1) All such industries which discharge some liquid effluents (below 500/kl/day) that can be controlled with suitable proven technology.
- (2) All such industries in which the daily consumption of coal/fuel is less than 24 mt/day the particulars emissions from which can be controlled with suitable proven technology.
- (3) All such industries employing not more than 500 persons. The following industries with adoption of proven pollution control technology subject to fulfilling the odour condition fall under this category:-
- 1. Lime Manufacture pending decision on proven control device and Supreme Court's decision fall under this category:-
- 2. Ceramics
- 3. Sanitary ware
- 4. Tyres and tubes
- 5. Refuse incineration (controlled)
- 6. Flour mills
