



The Current Cultural Heritage Conservation and Management Paradigm


Material culture is removed from cultural practices and nature ...thus alienating the community

Puri: Identified Heritage Zones



Zone 1: Shankh Kshetra

- Sahis with Mathas and other building of Heritage significance
- Lokanatha Temple Precinct

Zone 3: Balukhanda Recreational Zone

- 1. Revivial of *pokhris* in 11 Jagagharas *Shankashetra heritage zone*
- 2. Ghat building on the banks of the *River Musa Environmental zone*
