INDIA'S URBANISATION TRAJECTORY

- India is on the forefront of urbanization. By 2050, India's Urban Population is expected to grow around 880 million
- Share of Urban GDP is expected to be around 80%
- More and more people are living in towns, cities and hinterland villages with closer proximities
- On an average, large Indian cities are physically expanding by 20-25 sq.km/Year

Five states are likely to be more than 50 percent urbanized






Urbanization in India (Projections)







Growing Significance of Secondary and Tertiary Cities











Economic Geography of Top 10 Indian Cities






• Indian cities, under the current Urban Planning system and Capacities have largely been excluded from the process of economic development.

- 1. Urban Planning Data Collation and Up dation of Base Maps (Non existent in most cities in India)
- 2. Periodic Analysis of Spatial Growth within a City
- 3. Preparation of Urban Plans (Maha-Yojna for 10-20 Years)/GIS Based Master plans/ and Sector/Zonal Plans/Micro Level Plans (TP Scheme)
- 4. Support UDAs and Others in Plan Preparations
- 5. Granting Building Use Permissions
- 6. Land Acquisition for Physical and Social Infrastructure or Co-ordination with Infrastructure Delivery agencies/Engg department
- 7. Enforcement /Encroachment Removals/Demolitions



- 1. Modernization of the recruitment rules and accelerated filling up of the sanctioned posts
- 2. Regional Cluster Based Differentiated Approach:
 - A State Level Urban Planning Unit with 8-10 Urban Planners
 - Global Urban Planning experts for City-Region/Growth Corridors
 - City Level Urban Planning Cores in All UDAs and Growing Towns
 - Professional Core of 5-7 Urban planners at the Regional /Divisional Level (Differentiated Approach according to urbanization propensity)
- 3. Partnership with Private Sector Agencies and Universities/Academia
- 4. Region Wise Capacity Hubs/Nodes
- 5. Partnership with National and Global Urban Planning Knowledge HUbs
